Lake Trust Foundation Cereal Drive Provides 42,984 Meals for Local Children

(Brighton, Michigan) The Lake Trust Foundation's inaugural Employee Foundation Summer Cereal Drive is a success. The Foundation Cereal Drive, which was held throughout the week of June 5, 2017 was an employee effort to help provide meals for children who may have gone without for the summer. And today, the Credit Union announced that the effort will provide 42,984 servings of cereal, or meals, for 500 Michigan children for the duration of the summer.

Lake Trust employees from around the state pulled together to donate a total of 21,492 servings of food, and that donation doubled when the Lake Trust Foundation matched the entire amount, bringing the total to 42,984 servings. Along with the Cereal Drive, the Credit Union held a challenge for its employees, and the winning team, a collaboration of a Brighton headquarters Support Department and the Credit Union's Chelsea and Ann Arbor, Stadium branches, added the Lake Trust Foundation's match to the donation they made to their local food banks.

"Through conversations with local Food Banks, we've learned that summer is a particularly important time to donate, as kids are out of school and don't have access to free or reduced price lunch programs," said Brandalynn Winchester-Middlebrook, Lake Trust Credit Union Vice President of Culture and Engagement. "The opportunity for our team to help provide for these children is truly incredible, and we're grateful for all that our Food Banks do to make a difference."

The Credit Union's donation will support these community food banks across the state:
