## Free Mask Drive Through Event at Hamburg Senior Center on January 26

HOWELL, Michigan. - (January 19, 2021) The Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) received an allotment of KN95 masks from the state to provide to the public. LCHD has partnered with Hamburg Township to set up a drive through mask distribution site on Tuesday, January 26 from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Free KN95 masks will be available at the Hamburg Senior Center located at 10405 Merrill Rd, Whitmore Lake, MI 48189. The drive through event is open to all Livingston County residents. Individuals can pick up masks for themselves, or their family, friends, and neighbors. Both adult and youth size masks will be available. Masks will be distributed on a first come, first served basis.

Although vaccine distribution in the county is taking place, it is still important to wear a mask to protect yourself and others around you until more people can receive the vaccine. LCHD encourages residents to continue to wear masks, social distance from those not in their household, and wash their hands often, even after receiving the vaccine.
