COVID-19 Vaccination Appointments Available for Individuals 12 and Older

HOWELL, Michigan. - (May 12, 2021) Following the recommendation from the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) for the use of the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine among minors ages 12 to 15, the Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) is now offering COVID-19 vaccination appointments to individuals aged 12 and up.

LCHD is holding a clinic on Wednesday, May 19 from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to accommodate the newly eligible age group. The clinic location is Chilson Hills Church, 4440 Brighton Rd., Howell, MI 48843. Parents are encouraged to schedule an appointment for their eligible children. Anyone 12 and older is welcome to schedule an appointment here: <https://app.acuityscheduling.com/schedule.php?owner=21509694&calendarID=5497043>. Second dose appointments will automatically be scheduled for June 9 at a similar time. A parent or guardian must be present with their minor child at the time of vaccination.

In addition to the Pfizer vaccine, this clinic will also offer the Janssen, or Johnson & Johnson vaccine for individuals 18 and older.
