Community Catalysts Development Company Purchases the Former Crest Motel to Provide Transitional Housing in Livingston County

Community Catalysts Development Company, a Livingston County-based nonprofit providing attainable housing for seniors, veterans, homeless, and other lower-income people, has purchased the former Crest Motel and will rehab it into an extended-stay facility with weekly and monthly rental options.

Together with Community Catalysts, the Development Company will completely restore and expand the outdated motel through a complete building rehab and the conversion of former garage space into additional living space. It is estimated that this project will be completed in 7 months.

With a new name, Bethel Suites will feature an expansion from the existing 11 units to 14 newly-furnished units ranging from a "motel style" room with a bathroom to "apartment style" living. The goal of this project is to provide comfortable, safe, extended-stay, transitional housing for people in our community who need it.

"We are thrilled to support our community by quickly introducing 14 units of transitional housing into Livingston County. This project will be a great complement to the 3 other projects we have completed in the county over the last 2 years" said Eileen Zilch, Executive Director, Community Catalysts Development Company. "We are working with our community partners to solve one of our biggest local problems - housing for lower-wage workers - so that together we can put people on the path to stability and self-sufficiency."
