Howell, Michigan — Michigan veteran nonprofit VETLIFE brings the veteran community the largest FREE veteran event in the State of Michigan. VETLIFE co-founder Joshua Parish says, "Michigan is home to almost 600,000 veterans, but in 2019 less than 12% were connected to a federal benefit. VETLIFE co-founder Cortnie Parish says, "There are over 43,000 female veterans in the State of Michigan and many of them have never been recognized for their military service. We wanted to change that at this years Vet Fest so we worked with our community partners at FORD and CONSUMERS ENERGY to recognize our female heroes."

Vet Fest is completely free to the veteran and their family and we want to encourage our veterans to search out their benefits which is why we bring vetted resource providers to the event to help connect the to those military benefits.
