To be eligible to work an election, you must:

- be a U.S. citizen
- be registered to vote in the State of Michigan (with a special exemption for those who are 16 or 17 and willing to serve.)
- declare a party affiliation (independent or unaffiliated are not accepted)
- not have any felony convictions, or have been found guilty of an election related crime
- not be a candidate on the current ballot (or immediate family member of one) or a poll challenger during the current election cycle.

We invite everyone to consider fulfilling a public duty and helping to administer an upcoming election. The following will be election days in 2026:

Tuesday, August 4, 2026

Early Voting: Begins Saturday, July 25, 2026, and ends Sunday, August 2, 2026

Tuesday, November 3, 2026

Early Voting: Expected to begin Saturday, October 24, 2026, and end Sunday, November 1, 2026.

Key Races In 2026:

Governor & Lt. Governor; (1) U.S. Senate seat; All 13 U.S. House Congressional seats; All seats in the Michigan House and Senate; Secretary of State, Attorney General, (2) Michigan Supreme Court seats, plus additional state and local positions, including Clerk and (1) Trustee position in Genoa Township.

\* There could potentially be a special election on Tuesday, May 5 for School Related Millages or Bond issues.
